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#### **School Annual Education Report (AER) Cover Letter**

Dear Parents and Community Members:

We are pleased to present you with the Annual Education Report (AER), which provides key information on the 2023-24 educational progress for Ida Elementary School. The AER addresses the complex reporting information required by federal and state laws. The school's report contains information about student assessment, accountability, and teacher quality. For the 2024-25 school year, schools were identified based on previous years' performance using definitions and labels as required in the Every Student Succeeds Act (ESSA). A Targeted Support and Improvement (TSI) school is one that had at least one underperforming student subgroup in 2023-24. An Additional Targeted Support (ATS) school is one that had a student subgroup performing at the same level as the lowest 5% of all schools in the state in 2021-22. A Comprehensive Support and Improvement (CSI) school is one whose performance was in the lowest 5% of all schools in the state, had a graduation rate at or below 67%, or failed to exit ATS status in 2021-22. Some schools are not identified with any of these labels. In these cases, no label is given.

Our school has not been given one of these labels.

One key initiative at Ida Elementary is the implementation of our M.T.S.S. (Multi-Tiered System of Support) program, which provides small group and/or one-on-one help for students who are behind in literacy and/or math. Our classrooms and teachers have also made an effort to increase technology integration in classroom instruction with access to class sets of Chromebooks and iPads for student use.

Ida Elementary has also implemented all elements of the 3rd Grade Reading Law, including comprehensive training for our staff. We have ensured the integration of essential literacy practices and developed Individual Reading Improvement Plans (IRIPs) for students performing below grade level in reading. Additionally, we are working to adopt the principles of the Science of Reading to inform our instruction and support student progress. To further enhance our efforts, we collaborate with our ISD's grant-funded Early Literacy Coaches, who work directly with our teachers to implement best practice reading strategies based on the latest research.

State law requires that we also report additional information.

- 1. **PROCESS FOR ASSIGNING PUPILS TO THE SCHOOL** All students are assigned to our elementary school because it is the only choice in Ida.
- 2. THE STATUS OF THE 3-5 YEAR SCHOOL IMPROVEMENT PLAN We are continuing with our MICIP goals of improving English/Language Arts skills, improving Math skills, improving Science knowledge, and improving Social Studies knowledge by implementing best practices and evidence-based strategies to meet our student needs. We have also been focusing on enhancing instructional practices, fostering a positive learning environment for all students, expanding professional development opportunities for staff, and emphasizing data-driven decision-making. Our teachers continue to meet regularly to analyze data and ensure that we are utilizing appropriate goals for our students to close achievement gaps and support all students in reaching their full potential.
- 3. **A BRIEF DESCRIPTION OF EACH SPECIALIZED SCHOOL** We only have one elementary school that all students attend.
- 4. **CORE CURRICULUM** Our curriculum follows the state and Common Core standards and we have curriculum maps created which are housed in our shared district curriculum map drive. Grade level teams review these maps regularly and update as needed. All grade levels implement the same curriculum and work together in teams to ensure cohesiveness.
- 5. **STUDENT ACHIEVEMENT RESULTS** The NWEA local results are attached to this report including results from previous years.
- 6. **PARENT-TEACHER CONFERENCES** This year we had 498 families attend conferences which equals 94% of our students. Our teachers also communicate with families on a regular basis outside of parent-teacher conferences to ensure they remain engaged in their child's education. Additional data broken down by grade level is attached to this report.

We look forward to continuing to provide quality educational opportunities and experiences for our school community, and welcome any comments, concerns or questions you have.
